Description of Scholarship: As part of our dedication to excellence in education, the Hopkinton, NH Rotary Club offers up to **\$10,000.00** in scholarships annually. These scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis to Hopkinton High School seniors who plan to further their education at an accredited four or two year college, university or an accredited vocational institution. Scholastic achievement is only one of the criteria that will be considered; we seek students who also display excellence in leadership, community service, extracurricular activities, and/or personal achievement. Scholarships will be awarded during the high school awards night ceremony and will be paid prior to the start of the Fall Semester, after the student has registered.

- This completed and signed application form
- Your high school transcript
- One recommendation from a teacher, principal, or guidance counselor (this can be the same recommendation that was sent to colleges).
- One personal recommendation from an adult (other than a relative or local Rotary Club member) who knows you in a non-academic capacity. For example, your minister, neighbor, employer, athletic coach, or advisor for an extra-curricular activity would all be appropriate.
